## ADDITIONAL TENEMENT APPLIED FOR TO ENHANCE ESMERELDA PROJECT

Metallica Minerals Limited (ASX: MLM) has defined an undercover gold-copper-graphite regional exploration opportunity approximately 80 km south of the Croydon Goldfield.

Metallica had previously announced a new tenement EPM(A) 27210 'Clara' was applied for on 1 March 2019. Since acquiring the Clara tenement, Metallica has undertaken desktop studies to better define the previously identified mineralisation target areas.

As a result of positive desktop studies at the Clara tenement and surrounding areas, Metallica has identified a number of additional intrusive-related gold and base metal mineralisation targets and thus applied for an additional tenement EPM(A) 27290, due west of the Clara tenement (Figure 1).

The new tenement "Momba" consists of 89 sub blocks, and augments Metallica's graphite, gold and base metal exploration in the region.

Metallica is continuing to progress the Clara and Momba applications and plans to commence preparations for a drilling program, to test coincident priority magnetic and gravity geophysical targets, whilst the EPMs are being granted.

Metallica emphasises that its primary focus remains on progressing the Urquhart Bauxite Project in Far North Queensland.
